The German Association of Cities, consumer centres and many other associations have already joined the calls to save energy.

Ordinances on energy conservation issued at federal leve

On 24 August 2022, the Federal Cabinet adopted two energy saving ordinances:

An ordinance to secure the energy supply via short-term measures (EnSikuMaV), which will apply from 01.09.2022 until 28.02.2023. This regulates measures to save energy in public buildings/facilities, companies and private households. These precautionary measures are intended to avoid unnecessary energy consumption, in order to prevent or mitigate a shortage situation as far as possible.

These new regulations do not apply to schools, daycare centres, clinics, care facilities or other social institutions!

The second regulation contains measures effective in the medium term (EnSimiMaV), which will additionally come into force on 01.10.2022 and will apply for two years.

Effects on the city of Rinteln

- During the heating season, public buildings are only heated to a maximum of 19 degrees Celsius
- Corridors, foyers and technical rooms are no longer heated, except for safety related reasons
- No lighting of buildings and monuments from the outside, with the exception of security and emergency lighting
- Street lighting will be switched off between 01.10.2022 and 31.03.2023 in the time between 22:00 and 06:00. Exceptions to this are areas where traffic safety obligations must be complied. For instance, pedestrian crossings and sections where an increase in potential danger (crime, vandalism, etc.) cannot be ruled out.
- Gymnasiums remain opened, information on energy saving is displayed in the respective halls
- Indoor swimming pools in Steinbergen and Rinteln remain open, water temperature is reduced to 27 degrees and shower temperature is lowered.

About the background

Both regulations form the third pillar of the energy security package, alongside the filling of gas storage facilities and the reduction of gas consumption in electricity generation. According to the federal government, the measures in the two new regulations can save an estimated 10.8 billion euros in energy costs over the next two years in private households, the economy and the public purse.
